Curro Aurora offers four scholarship opportunities for learners that excel in different fields of interest.

Learners who meet the following requirements are invited to apply:

- Will be in Grade 8 in 2021
- Is a top 10% academic achiever at their school (academic scholarship), and/or
- Is a sportsperson who has achieved at district-level or higher (sports scholarship), and/or
- Excels in cultural endeavours, e.g. music, drama, dance (culture scholarship)
- Is in a leadership position at school

The closing date for applications is Thursday, 19 March 2020.

Please include all the required documents when handing in your application form.

Applicants not currently enrolled at Curro Aurora must complete an enrolment application form and submit it along with the scholarship application form. The enrolment application form can be downloaded from our website. However, current Grade 7 learners at Curro Aurora do not need to complete enrolment application forms to be considered for a scholarship.

## Scholarship information

Curro Aurora awards high school the following scholarships for excellence in the fields of academics, culture, sport and leadership.

- **Academic scholarships**

Learners in the top 10% of their grade and achieving an overall average of 80% or more, are invited to apply for an academic scholarship.

- **Sports scholarships**

View the fact sheets on our website to see which sports activities we offer.

Learners who have been selected for and participated in any of these sport disciplines at a district level or higher are invited to apply for a sport scholarship.

- **Culture scholarships**

View the fact sheets on our website to see which cultural activities we offer.

Learners who have received recognition and awards on a school level or from an accredited examination body, e.g. The National Eisteddfod Academy (NEA), or learners who have been cast in a professional production, are invited to apply for a culture scholarship.

- **Leadership scholarships**

Learners in a leadership role, e.g. head boy, head girl, deputy head boy/girl or school councillor who do not qualify to apply for an academic, sports or culture scholarship, are invited to apply, provided their overall academic average is 75% or above.

### General scholarship information

- Grade 8 scholarships are awarded for the high-school career, but are reviewed annually.
- Grade 8 scholarship applicants must be available to write a scholarship examination in English, Mathematics and Afrikaans/isiZulu.
- Grade 9 to 11 learners must apply to the phase head by the end of term 2 for the following year. These scholarships are awarded subject to learner eligibility, budget allocation and at the discretion of the executive head.
- Learners who do not participate in the discipline of the scholarship awarded to them will be at risk of having the scholarship revoked.
- The scholarships offered are partial scholarships providing special savings on tuition fees only (textbooks, stationery, tablets, uniform, camps and other costs are not included).
- The closing date for the scholarship application is final. No late applications will be considered.
- The scholarship panel comprises of the head of high school, academic head, deputy head (FET phase), deputy head (senior phase), head of sport, and head of culture.
- The final awarding of scholarships and the percentage savings on the school fee are made at the discretion of the executive head of Curro Aurora.
- Curro Aurora reserves the right to not award scholarships.
