## GENERAL

### 1. School fees

School fees for 2020 exclude the following:

- Textbooks and stationery (including e-books) – certain textbooks for Grade R to Grade 6 will be invoiced on statement
- Diaries – invoiced on statement, Grade 3 to Grade 7
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for school excursions and sports trips, unless otherwise advised by the school
- Enrichment and compulsory activity programmes – invoiced on statement, due by 2 February 2020, deducted with debit order in January 2020
- Grade 12 IEB exam fees – invoiced separately on statement
- Visual testing Grade R to Grade 3
- The e-learning device (tablet) and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device
- School uniforms
- Therapists' or psychologists' fees

### 2. Castle

- Full-day hours: 07:00 – 17:30
- Half-day hours: 07:00 – 13:00
- Penalty fee for late collection: R150 per half an hour or part thereof
- Castle holiday aftercare: R200 per day
- A full calendar month's notice in writing is required to change from half day to full day or from full day to half day
- The Castle is not open on public holidays and closes on 11 December 2020

Castle fees include:

- Healthy meals: breakfast, lunch, mid-morning and mid-afternoon snack
- All educational material

Castle fees exclude:

- Baby formula, nappies, wet wipes and baby toiletries
- Some optional activities may carry a charge

### 3. Aftercare

- The aftercare fees are invoiced to the school-fee account.
- A cooked meal and a snack are included in full-day care.
- Supervised limited-support homework classes will take place every school day afternoon as follows: foundation phase from 14:00 – 15:00 and intersen phase from 15:00 – 16:00.
- These classes exclude specialist subject and homework support.
- Learners provide their own stationery for homework.
- Aftercare is signed up for a term at a time, a term being three months as per the school calendar.
- Any cancellation requires a full calendar month's notice before the end of a term.
- The holidays referred to are school holidays.
- The aftercare is not open on public holidays and closes on 11 December 2020.

- There are no additional levies, although some optional activities during the holidays may carry a charge.
- Holiday care: no charge for learners attending aftercare during the term. This excludes day visitors.
- Penalty fee for late collection: aftercare closes at 17:30. A R150 penalty fee per half an hour or part thereof for first-time offenders and R150 per 15 min. or part thereof for repeat offenders.

#### 4. E-learning devices (tablets)

E-learning devices (tablets) will be utilised by all learners from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

This will have the following impact on you:

- If your child is in Grade 8 to Grade 12, you will be responsible for purchasing an e-learning device (tablet) for your child to use. The school will provide you with details and the minimum specifications required for the device.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and general maintenance and care of the device.

#### 5. Savings

Savings are applicable only to the tuition portion of the fees.

- **Annual saving:** 5% granted on a 12-month advance payment, which is strictly due by 31 January 2020.
- **Family saving:** a 5% saving will be granted on the annual and monthly school fees of the younger siblings.
- **Development bond saving:** development bondholders receive an additional R450 monthly saving or  
R5 400 on annual fees per bondholding learner.
- **Bursary:** awarded bursaries are deducted only on the tuition fee portion and after all other savings.

#### 6. Notice periods

- For notice to leave the school: three full calendar months' notice is required.
- A full calendar month's notice is required for any changes to or cancellation of services. This includes sports programmes and Castle full/half-day changes.
- If the full three calendar months' notice is not received, fees for the full three months will still be payable.
