
The Minister of Basic Education, Angie Motshekga, announced South Africa's return-to-school plans. Schools will reopen on 1 June 2020 for Grade 7, Grade 12 learners and specific small schools. Please note that we will provide detail in terms of the impact of this announcement on our schools and the rest of the academic year as soon as the Department has engaged with independent schools. As an independent group of schools, we will be exploring the options of a phased return. As indicated by the Minister, she will provide the detail in terms of independent schools soonest. Once received, we will align our return-to-school plans to support the key objectives of the Minister and communicate accordingly.

CHANGING YOUR CHILD'S MS TEAMS PASSWORD

Keeping teachers, learners and our data safe is a priority for Curro. Many learners are still using their original passwords which creates a risk, especially for cyber-bullying. **Learners are accessing other learner accounts using the generic passwords and posting inappropriate messages and images.** This is on the increase and we need to urgently address this. Even in times of crisis, we cannot compromise security and learners' well-being.

Please can you assist your child to reset their passwords as soon as possible, especially if they are using original passwords created. Passwords need to be at least 8 characters long and include a combination of special characters, letters and numbers. There is a step-by-step guideline below.

Please note that if learners do not change passwords, we will we have no choice but to do a forced password reset for all Curro Aurora users.

Steps to follow:


1. Open your browser. (Chrome, Firefox, Safari)
2. Go to Office.com



3. Click on sign in



4. Sign in with Curro credentials



5. Accept the certificate
 - a. Click on advanced
