**HOLIDAY AFTERCARE**

School reopens on Monday, 6 July 2020, when Aftercare will resume as normal until 17:30 each day after school. It is essential for Aftercare to be informed of the number of children attending Holiday Care in order to determine the logistical needs. Should you wish for your child to attend, then please complete the survey that was e-mailed home.

“Casual” and/or part time aftercare children are required to pay R 220.00 per day for Holiday Aftercare. Our fun filled holiday programme includes arts and crafts as well as indoor and outdoor gaming activities. Learners can bring their own ‘electronics’ to Holiday Care, however, Aftercare staff accepts no liability for loss or damages. Please remember the ‘no hat-no play’ policy. Bicycles are allowed on Fridays.
