1. Order lists should be completed in full and in clear block lettering. Where parent and student names differ, BOTH names must appear clearly on the order form.
2. **Orders can be placed via the following options:**

3. Payments for textbooks may ONLY be made via Electronic Fund Transfer (EFT).
4. **The following reference MUST PLEASE appear on all of EFT's: 5 2 3 4 8 0 followed by the Family Code and Grade (2021)**
5. Order forms will be dated as soon as they are submitted to Afro School and will be processed **STRICTLY ACCORDING TO SUBMISSION DATE**. All account, payment, order and delivery enquiries should be directed to **Afro** and **NOT** to the school.
6. **Once placed, orders CANNOT BE CHANGED OR CANCELLED**. All **Late Orders** will be handled as explained on the Order form.
7. Deliveries are scheduled for late 2020 or early 2021 based on publisher's deadline. Each delivery will be accompanied by feedback on the status of outstanding books.
