GENERAL

1. The following will be for the parent's/guardian's account:

- The e-learning device and any insurance, maintenance or other costs relating to the device
- All textbooks, workbooks, learning materials (including the cost of e-books) and stationery requirements – please contact the school for more information and related costs
- School uniforms and Curro sports gear
- Entrance fees, travel costs, accommodation and food for additional **non-compulsory school** excursions and sports/culture trips and camps, unless otherwise advised by the school
- School photos
- Therapists' and psychologists' fees
- Any costs related to special IEB/academic concessions, including scribes, readers, prompters, etc.

2. Bus fees

- Bus fees are charged over **12 months** and are therefore payable during school holidays.
- Notice period for bus cancellation is one month.
- Availability is limited and dependent on the assigned routes on offer

3. E-learning devices

E-learning devices will be utilised by all learners from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

This will have the following impact on you:

- You will be responsible for purchasing an e-learning device for your child to use. The school will provide you with details and the minimum specifications required for the device.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and general maintenance and care of the device.

4. Termination of enrolment

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.

5. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

Learners have access to a wider subject choice (beyond what we offer at school). These may be taken instead of any elective subject, or as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject. Additional costs as outlined below are applicable only when taken as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject.
