Please note that **cash payment at school is not accepted as a form of payment for fees.**

Early settlement

- 5% on school fees only if payment is made for 12 months in advance by 31 January 2027.
- Bi-annual payments can be made to settle fees for 2027. Pay for January to June by 31 January 2027 for 2.5% saving and pay for July to December by 31 July 2027 for 2.5% saving.

Payments

- The school fee payments may be made **annually** or **monthly in 12 equal instalments**, including January and December.
- **NOTE: Grade 12 school fee is payable over 11 months: January to November.**

DEBIT-ORDER COMPLETION

Debit orders substantially reduce the administrative burden when identifying deposits into our bank account and allocating them to the correct learner accounts. We rely on predictable monthly cash flows to pay teachers' salaries and to manage our operations, and trust that you will keep your accounts up to date.

GENERAL

1. The following will be for the parent's/guardian's account:

- School uniforms (including the Grade 12/Matric jacket) and Curro sports gear

2. E-learning devices

E-learning devices will be used by all learners from Grade 8 to Grade 12.

Note:

- You will be responsible for purchasing the e-learning device for your child to use. The minimum specification will be supplied by the school.
- You will be responsible for the insurance and the general maintenance and care of the device.

3. Termination of enrolment or educational services

Parents/Guardians may terminate the admission and enrolment or educational services of a learner after the commencement of the first day of the school year by providing the school with at **least 3 (three) calendar months'** written notice of termination.

4. Curro Choice: Wider subject choice offering

Learners have access to a wider subject choice (beyond what we offer at school). These may be taken as an 8th, 9th or 10th subject. Additional costs are outlined below.
